- ▲ Hepatology research flourishes at the Pittsburgh Liver Research Center, a P30 NIDDK Digestive Diseases Research Core Center, led by S. Paul Monga, MD, one of only three devoted to liver disease in the nation.
- ▲ University of Pittsburgh Department of Medicine NIH funding is ranked 6th among U.S. universities for competitive grants awarded to faculty members by the NIH, and 10th in federal R&D funding. The University of Pittsburgh as a whole, and the School of Medicine in particular, have more than doubled their NIH support since 1998. The University of Pittsburgh is the only school within the last 50 years to break into the top 10 of NIH-funded institutions.
- ▲ The CLD trains Advanced Fellows in Transplant Hepatology each year, and welcomes one of the largest Gastroenterology Fellow training programs in the U.S. with 19 trainees.
- ▲ UPMC will soon break ground on a billion-dollar state-of-the-art flagship hospital in Oakland (main campus).
