Rooted in the strength, resilience, and spirit of Pittsburgh, the **University of Pittsburgh Department of Medicine** is advancing healthcare through pioneering research, exceptional education, and compassionate care. Across **11 specialty divisions** and **2 research institutes**, our scientists and clinicians publish groundbreaking discoveries in high-impact journals, provide world-class patient care, and teach residents and fellows as part of a future where the strength that once forged steel now fuels medical breakthroughs, positioning the University of Pittsburgh Department of Medicine at the forefront of transformative medicine.

World-Class Clinical Care

- Patient care – our core mission – is fundamental to our educational and research programs. As a Department, we provide state-of-the-art healthcare that is compassionate, comprehensive, and easily accessible to our patients at **15 hospitals** and **140 clinics** across Pennsylvania.
- The Department of Medicine is focused on continuous quality improvement in all of the specialties provided, with **24 unique specialty clinics**.
- Our clinical providers promote the highest level of service orientation, achieving excellence in overall patient satisfaction with our clinical programs, with **106 clinicians** named to **Castle Connolly's Top Doctors** in 2026.

Innovative Research

- In FY2025, the University of Pittsburgh was the **7th highest recipient of NIH funding**, receiving over **\$660 million** in awarded support.
- The Department of Medicine secured the most NIH funding of any department at Pitt with over **\$195 million** in funding – **6th amongst internal medicine programs nationwide**.

Training the Next Generation

- The Department of Medicine has **9 T32/TL1** training grants and other internal/external funding mechanisms that support the research training of **103 postdoctoral fellows**.
- Within the Department of Medicine, career development awards from federal and foundation sources support over **40** junior faculty.
- The Department of Medicine has committed **\$500k** per year for Catalytic Grants to support the transition from K to R through the KARAT program.
